

ARRIVAL AT ROOSEVELT

DROP OFF FOR ALL STUDENTS — is in the back of the building. You will follow “dance studio signs” that will take you past the entrance and around the back of the building where the school buses drop off students. You will need to then return to the front of the building to enter for the performance. IT IS IMPORTANT THAT PEOPLE DO NOT TRAVEL THRU THE BUILDING AS I NEED TO KEEP TRACK OF STUDENTS AND KEEP THEM SECURE. AT INTERMISSION I WILL OPEN AN EASIER PASSAGE TO BRING YOUR CHILD INTO THE AUDITORIUM – BUT FOR PICK UP AND DROP OFF, PLEASE ONLY ENTER AND EXIT FROM THE BACK OF THE BUILDING.....

Pre / K groups should arrive 45 minutes before the recital, as students need to be taken by their parents to the restroom and be at their tables 30 minutes before we start.

Other dance students will also arrive 45 minutes before EXCEPT; Tuesday 5:45 MD, Tuesday 7:30 MD, Wednesday 5:45 MD, Wednesday 7:30 MD, Thursday 7:00 MD. The students listed need to be in their designated areas 90 minutes before their performance. This is vital as they will need to view stage details and places before the doors open for the public to enter the auditorium 30 minutes before the performance is scheduled to start. No one will be allowed to be seated (enter the house) until 30 minutes before the show. If your child is in both shows, please check with your student in between shows. Please be in your seat 10 minutes before the show starts.

THERE IS NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY ALLOWED AS IT ENDANGERS THE PERFORMERS. Especially during numbers where we have students who perform on the platforms. PLEASE DO NOT EVER ENDANGER OUR CHILDREN BY USING FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY, AND PLEASE INFORM GUESTS THAT YOU BRING WITH YOU TO NOT USE FLASH PHOTOTGRAPHY.

Each student will need their own snack, please pack **fresh fruit** in a ziplock baggie labeled with your child’s name. Each child should also have a water bottle with their name on it. Please do not leave your student without taking them to the restroom (even if they went just before they left home, please do not just ask them if they have to go – but instead, please take them to the rest room yourself before you leave them with us). Pre/k students are finished at intermission so that they can view the older students during the second half of the show. Please take this time to assist your child in viewing the older students – talk to your child about smiling, and using expression and energy when they perform. No performers are allowed in the house (auditorium) except the pre/k students and only after intermission. PLEASE DO NOT EXIT AFTER THEIR LAST NUMBER TO SEE YOUR CHILD – BUT WAIT INSTEAD UNTIL INTERMISSION. If you need to get up for any reason during the performance, audience members are asked to only get up in between numbers. NO ONE SHOULD BE OUT OF THEIR SEAT AND MOVING WHILE THE CHILDREN ARE PERFORMING.

Tips on applying make up

Please remember – this is not “day wear” make up – its ***theater make up*** to aid in the vision of your daughter on stage. So don’t let thoughts over take you on this --- and just enjoy enhancing your daughter’s features as she gets ready for stage. Please apply blush, lipstick and lip liner, eyeliner and mascara, eye shadow..... some helpful hints are below.....

Hair – must be in a bun. If their hair cannot reach a bun, the sides must be secured back so that they will not touch their hair during the performance. Headpieces are always on the performers right hand side unless we have stated otherwise.

Pre – K students

(all students who attend ½ hr and 45 min classes and wear white tap shoes)

Mascara - use black and apply either by allowing them to blink over the brush – or by closing their eyes and brushing the ends

Eye Shadow - earth tones (browns) please (DO NOT USE A COLOR) – brown in the recess areas and as white as you can get to highlight.

Blush - please use pink

Lipstick - please use bright pink – a liner is nice – it will hold the color and outline of their lips

Hour 45 minute students and older hip hop students

Mascara - use black

Eye Liner – use heavy black

Eye Shadow - earth tones (browns) please (DO NOT USE A COLOR) – brown in the recess areas and as white as you can get to highlight.

Blush - please use a blush that is deep and crosses between a pink and dark rose

Lipstick - please use **RED**– a liner is nice – it will hold the color and outline of their lips
